Thielman stated that these walking tours typically last around an hour and on average 12-30 people usually attend and they do have a speaker as a way to amplify the message for larger groups. Mathis asked if they would offer a make up date if it were to rain. Thielman replied typically they don't offer a make-up date but could consider one for this event especially if it were to be too hot. Meseke offered that the first hardware store is still standing and so is the first beauty shop on Fisher Street. Semelroth asked what date they were considering. Thielman stated that they usually happen on Tuesday nights – and that the week leading up to the 75th birthday would be perfect. Thielman also stated that she would follow up with an email to everyone with proposed routes and topics.
