- 2 City staff discussion: John Bender stated that because we have low attendance of committee members tonight we would just review the two current ordnances of 101, Storm Water Drainage Systems and 102, Illicit Discharge. We can do a markup of the comments and bring to the next meeting in September.
 - a. Ordinance 101 Storm Water Drainage Systems
 - The discussion of this ordnance was to update section 101.03 by removing the fee section and adding discussion the fee will be established from time to time by City Council action. This will eliminate the need to update this ordinance on an annual basis.
 - ii. The discussion of section 101.06 was to improve this section for a fee charge to private property if the City crews perform work on an emergency basis on a storm sewer system that was determined to be private. There are other City ordinances that allow for reimbursement of City time and materials if emergency work is preformed on private property.
 - b. Ordinance 102 Illicit discharge
 - i. The discussion of this ordnance was to update section 102.05 by removing the specified department that would be called out in an emergency in case of a spill of hazardous materials. The department might change depending on the nature of the hazardous material. This would require replacing the department name with "agency' throughout the ordinance.

ii. The discussion of section 102.09 was to replace the "City Administrator" with the "City Council" for any appeal action.
